“Hair is neat and well-groomed without elaborate or outlandish hairstyles, as determined by the administration. Boys’ hair should be clean, combed, cut above the ears, eyebrows, and collar. Girls hair should be clean, brushed, and worn out of the face.”

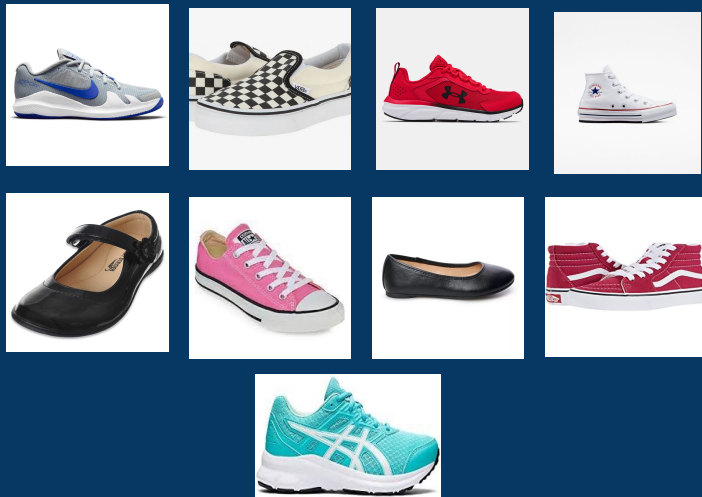


FOOTWEAR



“Any flat, closed-toe, closed-heel shoes. Tennis shoes, Toms, etc. in any color or color combination are all acceptable. NO neon, light-up, roller shoes, glitter, boots, wedges or wedge heels will be allowed. Shoe laces must match each other.”

SKIRTS & SHORTS & SHIRTS



“Navy, twill dress slacks or walking shorts, 2” from the back of the knee. Belt to be worn if slacks/shorts have belt loops. 3 - 8 Grade Christopher Plaid Skirt, 2” from the back of the knee. Preschool–2 Christopher Plaid Jumper, either style, 2” from the back of the knee.”

REGULAR UNIFORM DAYS



“Official St. John Bosco uniforms and PE must be purchased from Anton Uniforms.
 3-8 grade Christopher Plaid Skirt, 2” from the back of the knee Preschool–2 grade Christopher Plaid Jumper, either style, 2” from the back of the knee . Navy, twill dress slacks or walking shorts, 2” from the back of the knee. Solid black or navy belt with plain buckle. For grades PreK–2: belt is optional with twill dress shorts/pants. Belts are required for 3rd - 8th grades. Plain white, navy, or black socks or footed tights. Plain white, navy, or black socks or footed tights. Socks must be worn with all shoes. “

GYM UNIFORM DAYS



“Solid navy shorts 7”- 9” inseam, 2” from the back of the knee, creating a basketball shorts length. The current SJB gray t-shirt from Anton (no yellow printing) this the ONLY acceptable shirt to be worn for PE. In cold weather, navy or gray sweatshirts with the St. John Bosco logo may be worn at any time on campus. Tennis shoes in any color or color combination are all acceptable. Socks must be worn with all shoes”

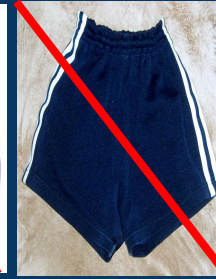

FREE DRESS DAYS



"Clothing must NOT be considered offensive in any way. Non-uniform shirts may be t-shirts or collared shirts of appropriate length and style. Non-uniform shorts, skirts, (2 inches above knee) or pants may be denim or appropriate material. Shoes must be flat and closed at the toe and heel. Shoes must be flat and closed at the toe and heel in accordance with regular uniform days."
