# Art Masterpiece Coordinator, Ashton Kelly:

- Quick numbers on CSW art masterpiece fundraiser:
  - 100% of preschool (3s & 4s) were purchased. 66% of K-5 were purchased. 33% of junior high was purchased.
  - We made \$5600 gross but expenses were \$1534 so we are expecting a \$4066 profit. This will be confirmed once the FACTS accounts are charged and I can verify with Kelly McLean.
