1. Diocesan School Board Fall In-Service Recap

- Sessions included updates on future scholarship programs, ESA utilization, and student well-being.
 - Logistics of the SGO (federal tax credit passed under HR1) is still being finalized by the government and actively monitored by the Diocese. No planned communications on this until finalized
- Emphasis on balancing digital and physical activities, fostering strong friendships, and keeping faith at the center of student life.

2. 5-Year Technology & Facilities Plan

- Recent improvements: new wrought-iron fencing, updated playground, water fountains/fill stations, and PE bathroom renovations.
- Near-term plans (1–2 years): shade structure for the lower court, new swingset, full school painting, HVAC replacements, and kindergarten bathroom renovation.
- Long-term plans (3–5 years): classroom expansion, MPR renovation, bathroom upgrades, nurse's office updates, roof and flooring replacements.
- Technology upgrades: new classroom screens, teacher copiers/printers, cloud-based IT system. Upcoming plans include Chromebook refresh, digital citizenship curriculum, and bandwidth expansion.
